The Livestock Center Auction Arena was the site of yesterday's Lim-Flex® and Limousin pen and carload shows. Judges Dan Hoge, Galva, IL.; Gordon Schuppe, Iliffe, CO.; and Craig Uden, NE., evaluated 19 Limousin bull pens, 11 Lim-Flex bull pens and 7 Limousin bull carloads.

In the carload show, Magness Land and Cattle's September–October 2008 bulls won grand champion; and Wulf Limousin Farms group of April 2010 bulls was the reserve grand champion. The People's Choice Award went to the April 2010 group from Running Creek Ranch.

The grand champion Limousin pen was a group of February–March 2010 bulls from Hager Cattle Co. Tubmill Creek Farm's March 2010 pen was the reserve grand champion. People's Choice Award went to.

A January 2010 pen from Magness Land and Cattle was grand champion and People's Choice champion of the Lim-Flex pen show. Tubmill Creek Farms reserve grand champion with its March–April 2010 pen.
