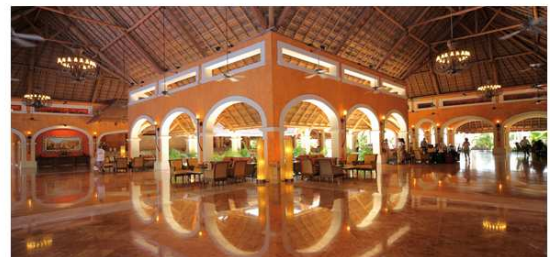

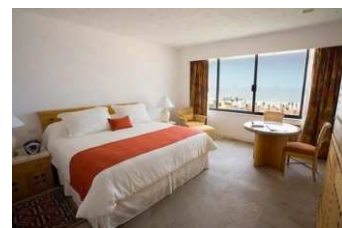

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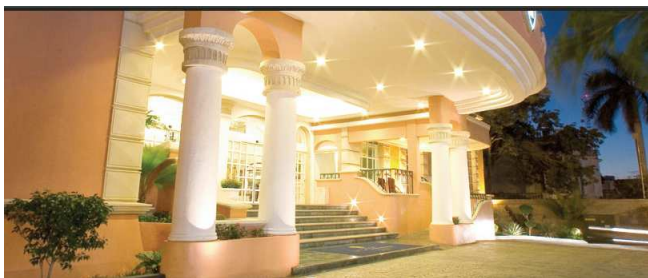
Merida, the capital city of the state of Yucatan, is a wonderful mixture of colonial city and cosmopolitan destination.

Known as "White City" because of the large use of white limestone and white paint, this traditional city depicts much of the splendour of Colonial Mexico. This is by no means to say that Merida still exists in a time warp and the contrary could be said. There is old and new exhibited in everything from fashion to architecture. Left in seclusion for many years because of the difficulty of travelling to Merida, the people of this region have cultivated a distinct contemporary society that is unique in Mexico.



Merida is a safe place to visit and the people are warm and friendly.

Hotel Presidente InterContinental Villa Mercedes



The Presidente InterContinental Villa Mercedes Merida is located right in the heart of the Yucatan's capital, Merida. This charming five star hotel was once a stately mansion built in the early part of the last century and blends the rich elegance and traditions of its past with contemporary comfort, welcoming visitors into a beautiful Lobby, a charming colonial terrace and an intimate courtyard pool.

Traditional Yucatecan and international cuisine are served in the hotel's restaurant, Frutas y Flores, including an extensive breakfast buffet with house specialties like mini-cheese rolls and freshly baked sweet rolls.

Built upon the ancient limestone ruins of the Mayan city of T'ho, Merida, the White City, is a city rich in history and folklore, cultural traditions, food and crafts. It serves as a gateway to the other Yucatan destinations, like the cobblestone streets of Izamal or the Mayan archaeological sites at Chichen Itza and Uxmal.



Day 1 – October 10th, 2010

- h Departure from Guadalajara Airport to **Merida**, with stop in Mexico City
- h Upon arrival in Merida, meeting with the guide and private transfer to **Hotel Intercontinental Presidente Villa Mercedes.**

Day 2 – October 11th, 2010

After breakfast at the hotel, the guide will accompany the group to the archaeological site of **Uxmal**.

Uxmal is said to be the most attractive of the archaeological sites; and an essential part of any visit to the archaeological sites of Mexico's Yucatan Peninsula.



Uxmal was an important city, probably build around 700AD, although inhabitants are thought to have lived in the area as far back as 800 BC - nearly 1,000 years before the city was built. It is a mystery as to why a settlement was ever made here: there are no rivers or local sources of water, and no evidence that they once existed. One of the features of Uxmal are the *Mayan chultunes* - or cisterns - which held water for the population to live from.

Uxmal is a delightful archaeological site to experience. The rich green fertile land provides a perfect setting for some of the most magnificent ancient pyramids, building and temples of the ancient world. You can sense the history here as walk around and gaze at the stunning architecture and majestic layout of this ancient city.

Lunch in a local restaurant and return to the hotel.

Day 3 – October 12th, 2010



After breakfast at the hotel, the day will be dedicated to the visit of the archaeological site of Chichen-Itza.

The archaeological site of Chichen-Itza served as the political and economic center of the Mayan civilization between 750 and 1200 A.D. Its stunning buildings which remain standing today are demonstrative of the Mayas' extraordinary commitment to architectural space and composition, as well as their vast astronomical knowledge. Chichén Itzá was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO and has been selected as one of the New 7 World Wonders.

After lunch, the guide will accompany the group to **Cancun**.
