Banquet Tickets

Banquet tickets are still available and will be available until 9 a.m. Wednesday morning, July 9. Tickets for those 13 and up are \$30, tickets for children age 12 and under are \$15.

Tie-Out & Bedding Material

Tie-outs are available in the Tommy Grant Arena located south of the Vance Reed Livestock Center, where the cattle will be stalled. Please refer to enclosed map for locations. Tie-outs will be bedded with straw prior to your arrival. Additional straw will be provided on a “help yourself” basis. Bedding fees will cover the first bedding in the barn and straw for tie-outs. Additional bagged shavings may be purchased through NALF’s Commercial Marketing Director Joe Epperly.

Feed Store

Hay and feed will be available from the local feed store. They will deliver daily. Please visit the show office for ordering information.

Check your Tattoos

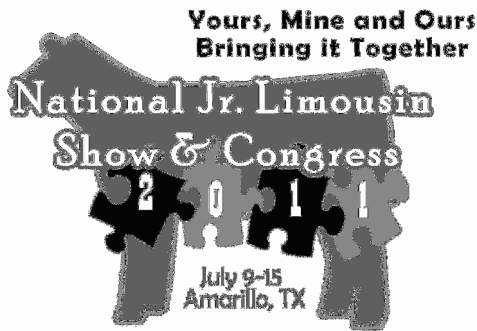
Please check all tattoos prior to departing for Amarillo. Cattle **MUST** have legible tattoos that correctly match the animal’s registration certificate. Re-tattooing at the show **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Health Requirements

A copy of the Texas Animal Health Commission Health Requirements can be found at <http://www.tahc.state.tx.us/regs/entry.html>. Please make sure you have your veterinarian issue the proper health papers in regard to Texas requirements. Be sure that you meet requirements for states that you will be traveling through as well. State officials have the right to request health papers at any time. **Have your health papers in order and with the cattle.**

Stalling & Arrival

Cattle may begin arriving on Saturday, July 9. All junior cattle will be stalled by state. Please refer to NALJA Show Rules for complete stalling details. Cattle entered solely in the All-American Limousin Futurity may not be stalled with junior show cattle.

Check in Procedures

NALJA Board Members and NALF Staff will read tattoos and check in cattle in the stalls. They will start Sunday morning at 8:30 a.m. After tattoos are read, steers and bulls will be directed to the scale area to be weighed. Members will also be directed to pick up their exhibitor packets at the show office at that time.

Showmanship

2011 will debut the revised showmanship contest. The first round of showmanship heats will be posted outside the show office on Saturday, July 9th. **Please remember to show in showmanship you must have entered on your entry form.**

Show Programs

Please watch for draft copies of show programs which will be posted in the barns and immediately report any changes or corrections to the show office by the posted deadlines. The steer, bred & owned and Lim-Flex show program will be posted Sunday evening, and the female show program will be posted on Monday morning.
