



## **Participation Requirements**

### **LimMark Producer/Participant Agreement**

Producer participants must complete a LimMark producer/participant agreement form before they can enroll cattle into the program. This agreement is available upon request from the North American Limousin Foundation (NALF).

### **LimMark Program Requirements**

LimMark program cattle must be sired by a registered Limousin or Lim-Flex bull. The NALF office supervises that requirement. Each bull listed in the Producer/Participant agreement by NALF or leased by the Producer/Participant permits the enrollment of up to 50 head per calving season.

### **LimMark Documentation Requirements**

In order to be eligible to enroll cattle in the LimMark program, all cattle must be accompanied by the LimMark Producer/Participant form, the correct genetic documentation, and must meet all eligible program requirements

### **LimMark Identification (Tags)**

Cattle that meet the LimMark Program Requirements and have the proper documentation are identified by tagging with the large, sky-blue LimMark identification source. Only cattle that are qualified and properly enrolled in LimMark may be tagged with the official LimMark ear tag. Limousin genetics are coupled with information that is submitted to the LimMark program for enrolled sets of calves.
