



Program Requirements

LimMark Genetic Eligibility

Only cattle sired by registered Limousin or Lim-Flex bulls are eligible for the LimMark program. Each bull listed in the Producer/Participant ownership by NALF or leased by the Producer/Participant permits the enrollment of up to 50 head per calving season. Each straw of semen purchased permits the enrollment of **one** calf. By enrolling cattle in LimMark, the Producer/Participant agrees to the following:

- All cattle enrolled in LimMark are sired by a registered Limousin or Lim-Flex bull.
 - Owned, leased, or AI Limousin and Lim-Flex bulls may be used, providing the appropriate documentation is available.
- All of the cattle enrolled were sired by eligible, recorded bulls.
- Only enrolled cattle will be identified by the LimMark, sky-blue identification.

LimMark Genetic Documentation Requirements

- If owned bulls are used, all bulls need to be correctly registered or transferred into the Producer's/Participant's name.
- If leased bulls are used, they need to be correctly registered or transferred into the owner's name, and proper documentation of the lease agreement must be attained.
- If AI bulls are used, all documentation of semen purchases must be kept.

LimMark Source

Only cattle that are enrolled by the original owner at the ranch of origin are eligible for the LimMark program. When declaring cattle eligible for the LimMark program, the Producer/Participant agrees to the following conditions:

- All of the cattle enrolled in LimMark are owned by the Producer/Participant and came from the farm/ranch identified by the member number.
- Only eligible cattle will be identified with the sky-blue LimMark tags.
