Stalling & Arrival

Cattle may begin arriving on Saturday, July 11. All junior cattle will be stalled by state. Please refer to NALJA Show Rules for complete stalling details.

Check your Tattoos

Please check all tattoos prior to departing for Amarillo. Cattle **MUST** have legible tattoos that correctly match the animal's registration certificate. Re-tattooing at the show **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Health Requirements

Please make sure you have your veterinarian issue the proper health papers in regards to Texas requirements. Representatives of the Texas Animal Industry Board may be present upon arrival of the cattle. **Have your health papers in order.**
