NWSS Includes 35 Limousin, Lim-Flex Pens, Carloads

The National Western Stock Show (NWSS) Limousin and Lim-Flex® pen and carload shows were Jan. 16 in Denver, Colo. Judges Mark McCully, Wooster, Ohio; Bob Miller, Rushmore, Minn.; and Jered Shipman, Lockney, Texas, evaluated 23 pens of Limousin bulls, five carloads of Limousin bulls, three pens of Lim-Flex bulls and four pens of Lim-Flex females.

The grand champion carload of Limousin bulls came from Magness Land and Cattle, Platteville, Colo. The 10 head had an average birthdate of Feb. 8, 2007; an average weight of 1,278 pounds; and an average weight per day of age (WDA) of 3.79 pounds. Sires represented in the group were MAGS Remote, LVLS Secret Weapon 4408K, KRVN Naskar 013N, JCL Lodestar 27L, EF Main Stay 541M, GPF Blaque Rulon and Carrousel Nasdaq.

The reserve champion carload of Limousin bulls also was the People's Choice award winner. The 10 head came from Coleman Limousin Ranch, Charlo, Mont. They had an average birthdate of Feb. 26, 2007; an average weight of 1,176 pounds; and an average WDA of 3.69 pounds. Sires represented in the group were COLE Magnum 15M, Carrousel Pure Power, COLE Black Tank 24P and EXLR Rebound 704R.

The grand champion pen of three Limousin bulls came from Express Ranches, Yukon, Okla. The Division 2 winner had an average birthdate of Feb. 5, 2007; an average weight of 1,177 pounds; and an average WDA of 3.46 pounds. Sires represented in the group were LESF Asphalt 9N and Carrousel Pure Power.

The reserve grand champion pen of three Limousin bulls, which claimed the People's Choice award, came from ROM'N Limousin, Arlington, S.D. Division 3's winning pen had an average birthdate of March 2, 2007; an average weight of 1,142 pounds; and an average WDA of 3.62 pounds. ROMN Justice, Wulfs Ransom 3059R and ROMN Made To Order sired the group.

The grand champion pen of three Lim-Flex bulls came from Magness Land and Cattle. It had an average birthdate of March 6, 2007; an average weight of 1,198 pounds; and an average WDA of 3.85 pounds. JCL Lodestar 27L sired one of the bulls out of HA Patricia 1104, and DHVO Deuce 132R sired the other two out of HA Blackcap 1089.

The reserve grand champion pen of three Lim-Flex bulls came from Coyote Hills Ranch, Chattanooga, Okla. It had an average birthdate of Sept. 24, 2006; an average weight of 1,492 pounds; and an average WDA of 3.15 pounds. Sires represented in the group were GPFf Blaque Rulon and JCL Lodestar 27L. Dams represented were KQ 9110J, CHR Lana Sue 321L and CHR Black Rouge 087M.

In the Lim-Flex female pen-of-three show, the grand champion came from Magness Land and Cattle. Those animals had an average birthdate of March 8, 2007; an average weight of 963 pounds; and an average WDA of 3.12 pounds. DHVO Deuce 132R sired the group out of Thomas Patricia 1897 and HA Blackcap 1089.

The reserve grand champion pen of three Lim-Flex females came from Logan Hills Limousin, West Harrison, Ind. It had an average birthdate of Sept. 2, 2006; an average weight of 1,120 pounds; and an average WDA of 2.26 pounds. JCL Lodestar 27L sired the entire group out of Kahn Rita B159.
